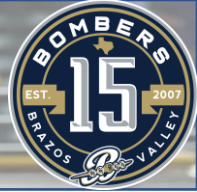

GO FETCH, FIDO: Although he has found himself in a recent power slump, Bobby Lada still holds the Bombers home run lead at 4, and finds himself tied for third place among the entire TCL, trailing Steven Rivas (VIC) and Peyton McGregor (AMA) with 9 and 6, respectively. Additionally, Ryan Snell still has the only first home run by a Bomber not named "Lada," pushing the team total to 5 by Brazos Valley.

BAR"K"ING UP A STORM: Brazos Valley continues to get swing and misses at the plate, leading the TCL in strikeouts recording by pitching with 249. However, the Bombers also have the most strikeouts at the plate, recording 221 in the first 23 games. As for recency against San Antonio, the Flying Chanclas held the edge with 37 K's versus Brazos Valley's 34 K's in the 3-game series last week.

MAN'S BEST FRIEND: Despite committing the most errors in the TCL, the Bombers have relied on the double play to get them out of tough situations this season. They lead the league with 16 twin killings, including a 4-6-5-2 variety in the second game in San Antonio. As for the Flying Chanclas, they have turned 11 of their own in their first 19 games.

SHOWING OFF WINNING WAYS: With a rich history of winning in the Brazos Valley, the Bombers struggled to do so in the middle of the first half. Finishing the first half with taking two of three in San Antonio and a two-game sweep over Acadiana, the Bombers find themselves back where they are familiar: securing wins. They will look to continue a three-game win streak, in hopes of taking a strong start to the second half into the upcoming July 4th break.
