"THAT'S THREE THUS FAR, SHOOTER": In the spirit of *Happy Gilmore*, the Bombers have their own trio of heavy hitters with Shelby Becker, Grayson Tatrow, and Bobby Lada. Becker leads in most hitting statistics, Tatrow has a nice 7-12 stretch in 3 games, and Lada has shown his power with 3 HRs.

"GO TO YOUR HAPPY PLACE": Despite the 8-6 loss last night, the Bombers showed promise in their first game back at the friendly confines of Edible Field. The loss pushed their record to 3-3 at home, which is considerably better than the 4-6 showing away from the Brazos Valley.

"DOUBLE OR NOTHING": The Bombers' offensive struggles have come and go, but one thing has remained consistent: Brazos Valley can find the outfield gaps, hitting 29 doubles in their 16 games, tied with San Antonio for the most in the TCL.

"IT'S ALL IN THE HIPS": Shortstop Bobby Lada has officially found his stride, launching 7 extra-base hits in the last 6 games he has played, including 3 home runs and 4 doubles. Additionally, he has performed well in the field, only committing two errors in over 40 chances on defense.

"SOMEBODY'S CLOSER..": Brazos Valley's bid for a second straight comeback victory failed, but not before they scored 5 unanswered runs after finding themselves in a 8-1 deficit. The Bombers have shown fight in each of their losses when they trail after 6 innings, only finding 1 win in 9 tries.

"JUST GO TO YOUR HOME": The Bombers' recent difficulties have been defined by their struggles in leaving runners on, more specifically hitting poorly with runners in scoring position. Brazos Valley is hitting 35-176 (.199) with RISP, not to mention leaving 120 men on base in 15 games.

"WHADDYA SAY? HOW BOUT A K?": Swings and misses have come easily for the Bombers pitching staff, leading the TCL in that category with 166 punchouts. However, just as easily, at the plate, Brazos Valley hitters have gone down on strikes the most in the league with 150 Bombers retired.

"IF I SAW MYSELF IN THOSE CLOTHES....": The Bombers will salute Happy Gilmore's Boston Bruins when they take the field on Friday night. In the first special theme night jersey of the season, the Bombers will wear the iconic bright yellow Bruins sweater with some Brazos Valley swagger.
